 - a. Why you're a good candidate to receive a cholarship that is based on financial need and merit.
 - b. The exact dollar amount your family can contribute toward the full program cost.
 - c. Details of any previous financial assistance you've received in the past toward school tuition and any other academic or personal development programs.
 - d. Any other relevant details to support your financial need.
- 4. A 500-word essay that describes why you want to participate in the program and how you believe it will benefit your long-term goals.
