HISTORY AND CIVILIZATION:


Dive into the history, civilizations, and significant historical events of Spanish-speaking countries.

Here are some important aspects to focus on:

VOCABULARY EXPANSION:

Continue to expand vocabulary to include more advanced and specialised terms related to various topics, such as professions, hobbies, technology, and current events. Encourage learners to actively seek out new words and expressions.

GRAMMAR REFINEMENT:

Deepen understanding of grammar concepts and expand knowledge of verb tenses, including the past tenses (preterite, imperfect, and past perfect), future and conditional tenses, subjunctive mood, and complex sentence structures.

FLUENCY AND EXPRESSIVENESS:

Be encouraged to engage in more spontaneous and extended conversations, discussions, and presentations. Focus on developing fluency, coherence, and the ability to express opinions, ideas, and arguments in a clear and organised manner.

PRONUNCIATION AND INTONATION:

Continue refining pronunciation skills, paying attention to accentuation patterns, intonation, and word stress. Work on reducing common pronunciation errors and sounding more natural in spoken Spanish.



LISTENING COMPREHENSION:

Listening activities that include a wider range of accents, dialects, and speech rates. Practice listening to authentic materials, such as podcasts, news broadcasts, and interviews, to improve comprehension skills.

READING COMPREHENSION:

Practice with more complex reading materials, including newspaper articles, short stories, and excerpts from novels. Focus on developing reading strategies, such as inference, context clues, and summarization.

WRITING SKILLS:

Write longer texts, such as essays, reports, or narratives, using more advanced vocabulary and complex sentence structures with your coach's guidance on organizing ideas, developing arguments, and improving overall writing proficiency.

CULTURAL UNDERSTANDING:

Deepen cultural awareness and understanding of Spanish-speaking countries by exploring literature, art, history, and contemporary social issues. Discuss cultural nuances, customs, and perspectives to enhance learners' intercultural competence.
